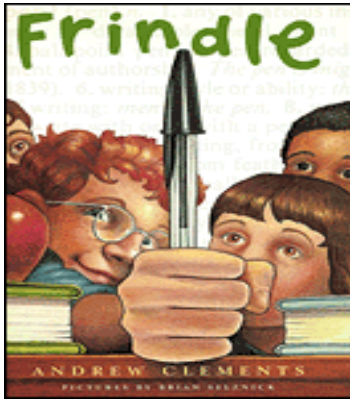

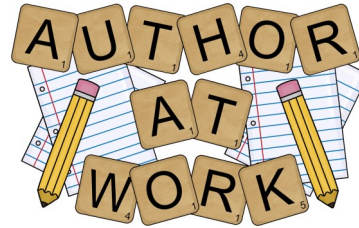
### Assembly
